Autumn Seasonal Planning Framework

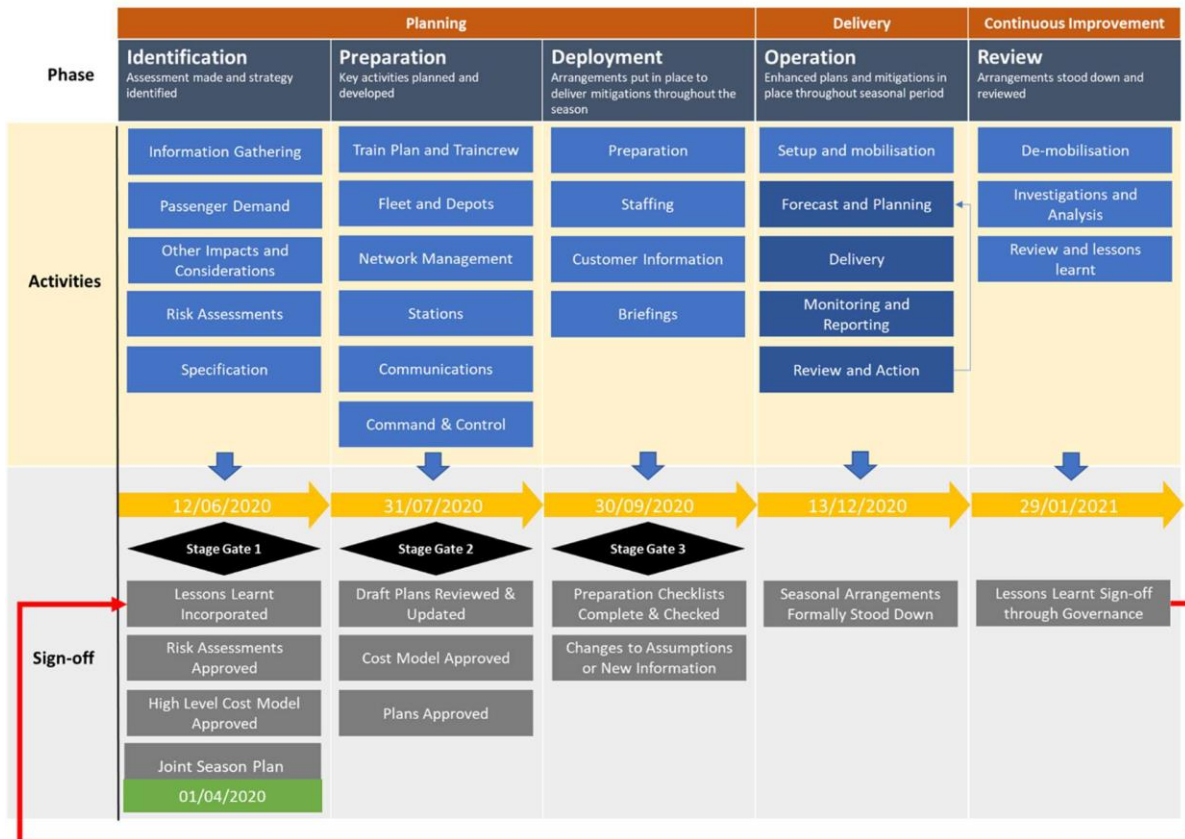


Figure 1 - Image represents new planning approach with milestone dates
